7. **Request for Alteration Permit for 610 Main Street.** A proposed façade update to correct a safety situation and to enhance the appearance of the storefront to be consistent with adjacent storefronts for a structure that is non-contributor to the Downtown Woodland Historic District.
8. **2011 Heritage Home Awards:** The Heritage Home Award is a public recognition award recognizing remarkable family homes and commemorates that home's contribution to the aesthetically and historically significant residential architecture of Woodland. The award is honorary and recognizes the home as a special community resource and recognizes those homes that have been well cared for or well restored.

This year's awards ceremony will mark the 23rd year the City of Woodland has presented the Heritage Home Awards to local homeowners. This year's awards will be presented to three homeowners.
