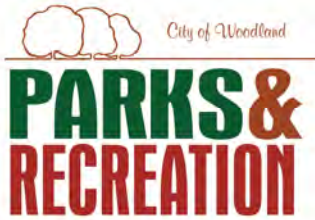

Many volunteers and sponsors helped make both events a success.

Important Document Workshop

The following marketing has been completed for the upcoming Important Document Workshop on January 23: promotion via social media site (City's Facebook), press releases sent to local newspapers, has been posted on the City's website and event calendar, and included SeniorGram the last two months. After the last Important Document Workshop, numerous requests came in for the handouts.
