

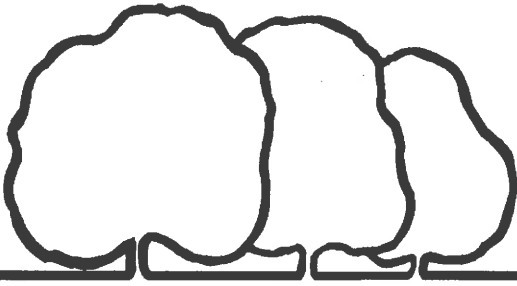

**4. Public Comments: None.**

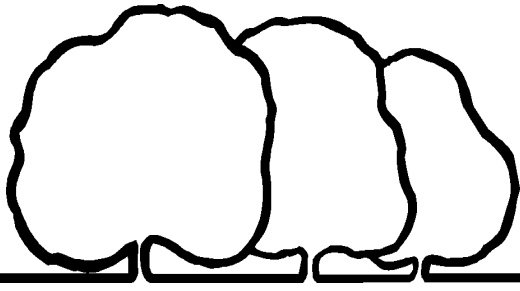
