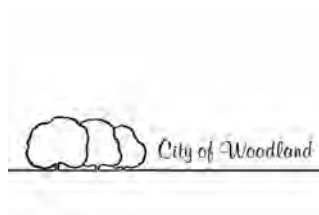

(2) This sub-committee will determine, among other things, the structure, purpose, definition, and obligations of the sub-committees and liaison positions. (3) This sub-committee will report back to the commission monthly, until all sub-committees and liaison positions are assessed or reconfigured or eliminated as seen fit.	Work in Progress
