## **Commission on Aging Work Plan (July 2019-June 2020)**

The following action plan contains 5 specific items that the Commission on Aging proposes to accomplish, or at least begin over the next year. General objectives, dates, and required resources are listed for the sake of planning. *However, they are subject to change as the year progresses and particular action items are moved towards implementation.*

Each action item, with a brief statement of objective, outcome, timeline, and resource requirements are as follows:

1. Intergenerational Project
2. Senior Resource Fair
3. Woodland Apartment List
4. Advocacy
5. Handicap Parking Spaces

### **1. Intergenerational Project (Commissioner Overholt & Wheeler)**

**Objective:** Recommend and support intergenerational project between seniors and children.

**Outcome:** Social benefit for young children and seniors.

**Timeline:** Ongoing.

**Required Funding:** Program costs, Commission and staff time.

### **2. Senior Resource Fair (All Commissioners)**

**Objective:** Inform seniors and their families/neighbors about senior programs in the community.

**Outcome:** Create greater awareness and participation in senior programs in the community.

**Timeline:** Ongoing.

**Required Funding:** Program costs, Commission and staff time.

### **3. Woodland Apartment List (All Commissioners)**

**Objective:** To complete annual update of the list of Apartment Complexes in Woodland, this includes apartments for 'seniors only'. Biannually Outcome: Provide current rental information for seniors and their families.

**Timeline:** January/February 2020.

**Required Funding:** Program costs, Commission and staff time

### **4. Advocacy (All Commissioners)**

**Objective:** To promote and advocate for issues related to seniors.

**Outcome:** To move issues related to seniors to the front of the legislative agenda.

**Timeline:** Ongoing

**Required Funding:** Program costs, Commission and staff time.

### **5. Handicap Parking at front of WC&SC (Commissioner Campbell/Kelley)**

**Objective:** Increased Handicap Parking Spaces.

**Outcome:** More accessibility at the main entrance for seniors.

**Timeline:** Ongoing

**Required Funding:** Program costs, Commission and staff time.

## **The Code of the City of Woodland, California**

### **Article VII. Boards, Commissions and Committees.**

#### **Part L. Commission on Aging.**

##### **Sec. 2-7-81. Creation.**

There is created a commission on aging. (Ord. No. 1035, § 9 (part).)

##### **Sec. 2-7-82. Composition.**

The commission on aging shall consist of five voting members who shall reflect the ethnic make-up of the senior citizens of the city. (Ord. No. 1035, § 9 (part); Ord. No. 1412, § 3 (part).)

##### **Sec. 2-7-83. Appointment and removal.**

Members of the commission on aging shall be appointed pursuant to Section 2-1-38. (Ord. No. 1035, § 9 (part); Ord. No. 1412, § 3 (part).) [\[see Sec. 2-1-38 below\]](#)

##### **Sec. 2-7-84. Terms.**

At expiration of each of the terms of members of the commission on aging provided under Resolution No. 2550 dated May 6, 1974, each successive member thereafter shall be appointed by the council for a term of four years and, unless sooner terminated, shall serve until his successor is appointed and qualified. However, if a vacancy shall occur other than by expiration, it shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired portion of the term. (Ord. No. 1035, § 9 (part).)

##### **Sec. 2-7-85. Jurisdiction.**

The commission on aging shall advise, and make recommendations to, the city council on all matters pertaining to senior citizens of this city. (Ord. No. 1035, § 9 (part).)

##### **Sec. 2-7-86. Powers and duties.**

The commission on aging shall have the following powers, functions and duties:

- (1) To act as advisory body to the city council by studying, evaluating, and making recommendations on grant and program proposals affecting the well being of senior citizens' programs in the city;
- (2) To define unmet needs of senior citizens and to identify ways to meet these needs;
- (3) To identify and inventory various services available to senior citizens;
- (4) To disseminate information to senior citizens regarding the availability and uses of the various activities and services;
- (5) To lend strength and support to existing programs;
- (6) To discuss and recommend appropriate action on all legislative bills concerning senior citizens;
- (7) To recommend and coordinate senior citizens' programs or services of general interest, including, but not limited to, nutrition, transportation, health, housing and recreation;
- (8) To act as advisory body to the city council concerning the operation and maintenance of the senior center;
- (9) To review the portion of the city budget related to senior programs as developed by the department staff and make recommendations to the city council. (Ord. No. 1239, § 2 (part); Ord. No. 1035, § 9 (part).)

**Sec. 2-7-87. Procedure.**

The commission on aging shall hold regular meetings during each calendar year at such time and place in the city as the commission may fix by resolution. The commission also shall adopt rules for conduct of its meetings in accordance with law and prepare and maintain a public record of its transaction of business which shall include its findings and determination on matters within its jurisdiction. (Ord. No. 1035, § 9 (part).)

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**Sec. 2-1-38. Appointment and removal.**

All appointees shall be appointed by the council to serve at the pleasure of the council. Such appointments shall be made only upon a motion, a second, and an affirmative vote of at least three members of the council and any appointee appointed by the council to serve on a board, commission or committee may be removed from such a board, commission or committee by the city council, without cause, upon a motion, a second, and an affirmative vote of at least three members of the council. (Ord. No. 935, § 2 (part); Ord. No. 1317, § 2 (part).)

**Fitness Programs at the Senior Center:** The Community Services Department has been busy adding to its repertoire of fitness classes for older adults. Staff has contracted with Kelly Ward, “The Fall Prevention Lady,” who facilitates classes on physical and brain exercises that aim to help those with mobility issues keep their balance and stay on their feet. Another fitness contractor, Steve Bonnell, has started a class called “Functional Fitness for Health and Vitality,” which is a higher-intensity workout for seniors. The City’s existing dance contractor, Dynamic Dancing with Yvette, has added two senior dance/fitness classes: “Creative Movement,” which is an exercise class using dance; “Stretch and Strength Basics,” which is a gentle exercise class using music as a guide; and “Get Up and Dance,” which is a dance program for active seniors.

**AARP Tax Aid:** For the 2019 tax season, the AARP Tax Aid appointments at the Woodland Senior Center have filled. There were 500 available appointment times and nearly all were utilized. This service began in February and will end on April 15.
