1. SUBJECT: Landmark Tree Nomination

RECOMMENDATION FOR ACTION: Staff recommends that the Historic Preservation Commission (1) Receive the staff report and consider the historical significance of the five trees recommended for designation as Landmark Trees; and ; (2) Recommend that upon approval by the Parks and Recreation Commission the City Council designate as Local Landmark Trees: two native Valley Oak (*Quercus lobata*) trees, located at the Gibson House property and a City tree located in the south planting strip at the intersection of Casa Linda Drive and Cleveland Street. The third is a London Plane (*Platanus x acerifolia*) tree located at 524 Third Street. The remaining two trees are Valley Oak (*Quercus lobata*) located at Dingle Elementary School and a Cork Oak (*Quercus suber*) at Beamer Elementary School.
