**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE PRESIDENTIAL
GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF WOODLAND ON
NOVEMBER 3, 2020**

WHEREAS, a Presidential General Election was held and conducted in the City of Woodland, County of Yolo, State of California, on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and regularly given in the time, form and manner as provided by law; voting precincts were properly established; election officers were appointed and in all cases said election was held and conducted, and the votes cast were received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in the time, form, and manner as required by the provisions for the Election Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Canvass and Statement of Results of Election dated December 1, 2020, the County Clerk-Recorder of the County of Yolo canvassed the results of said election and has certified the results to this City Council, and said results are received, attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit A.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLAND
DOES RESOLVE, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. The total number of ballots cast in the City of Woodland was 27,095.

SECTION 2. Said Presidential General Election was held for the purpose of electing three (3) members of the City Council for Council Districts 2, 4 and 5 with terms expiring upon the election of the successor thereto at the Presidential General Election in 2024 as required by the laws relating to cities in the State of California.

SECTION 6. The City Clerk shall deliver to each person elected a certification of election signed by her and duly authenticated; she shall also administer to the persons elected the oath of office prescribed in the State Constitution of the State of California and shall have those persons subscribed thereto, whereupon each person so elected shall be inducted into the office which he has been elected.
