SUBJECT: PUBLIC HEARING - Redistricting Public Hearing #2

Recommendation for Action: Hold a public hearing and receive public comment on draft council district map.

Discussion:

At the June 1, 2021 Council meeting, the City Council approved the formation of the Advisory Redistricting Commission (ARC) to draft and submit preliminary council district maps for the Council's consideration.

Since its formation, the ARC conducted various workshops throughout the community to receive public comment on communities of interest and draft maps. The ARC has reviewed the comments and proposed maps received during the outreach and has agreed on a draft council district map. Prior to finalizing its recommendation to the City Council, the ARC is holding a public hearing on February 24th at 6:30pm to receive comments on the draft map as well as additional proposed maps for their consideration.

The draft map was drafted in accordance with the Federal Voting Rights Act and the Fair Maps Act. For reference, the Fair Maps Act requires that, to the extent practicable, district lines will be adopted using the following ranked order criteria:

- (1) geographically contiguous districts (each supervisorial district should share a common border with the next)
- (2) the geographic integrity of local neighborhoods or communities shall be respected in a manner that minimizes its division
- (3) geographic integrity of a city shall be respected in a manner that minimizes its division
- (4) easily identifiable boundaries that follow natural or artificial barriers (rivers, streets, highways, rail lines, etc.)
- (5) lines shall be drawn to encourage geographic compactness. In addition, boundaries shall not be drawn for purposes of favoring or discriminating against a political party.

Given that the ARC is an advisory commission, the City Council is free to accept, reject, or alter any map submitted by the ARC. The Council could also provide direction to staff to draft new maps or for the ARC to consider additional maps prior to its adopting of a final map.

Pursuant to state law, the final map must be adopted by April 17, 2022.

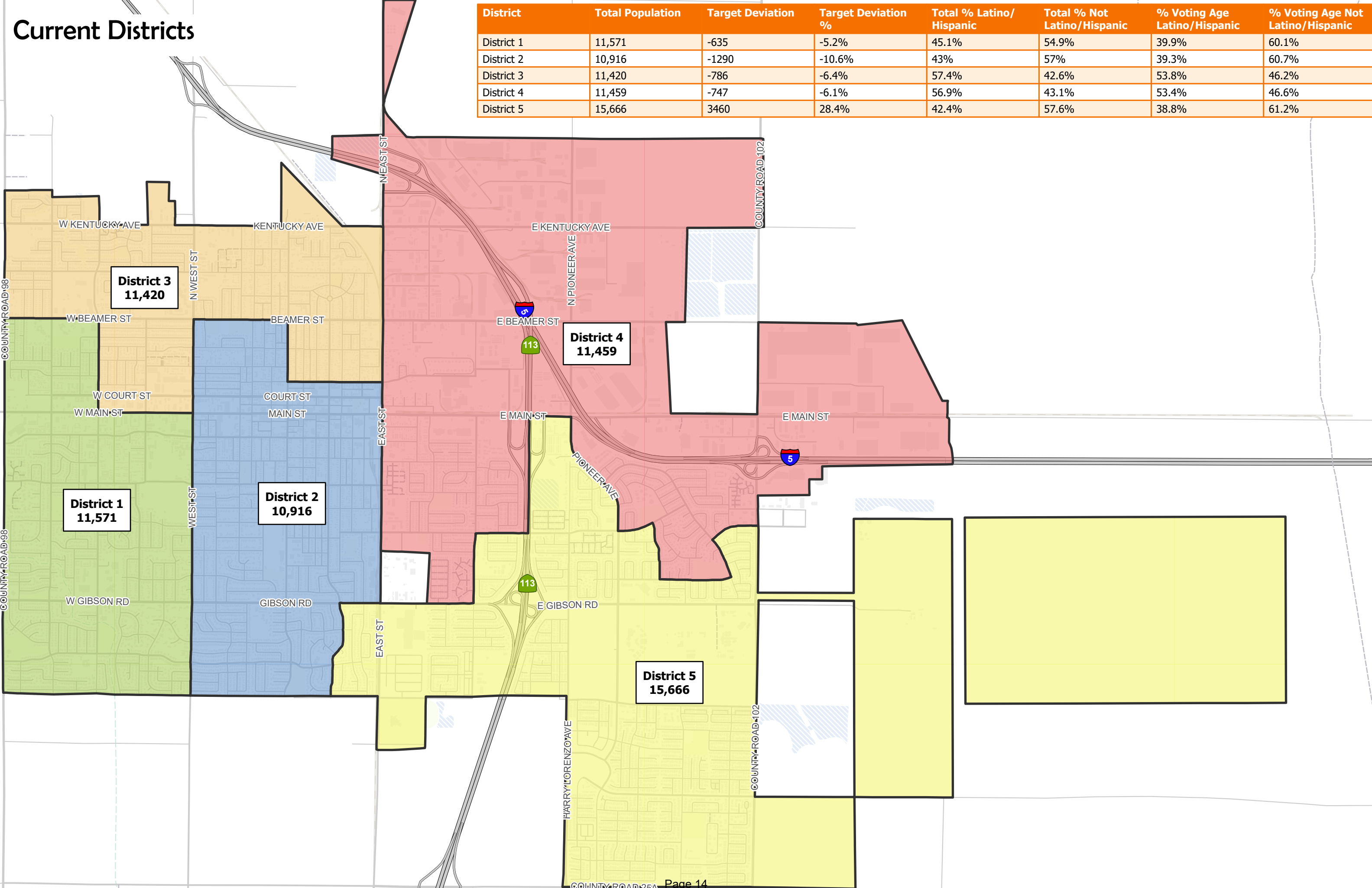
