Notes for the day:

- Enter the building through the main entrance and walk straight through the main lobby into the gymnasium. The sign-in table will be just outside the gymnasium doors.
- Table locations will be assigned by the Commission on Aging.
- Every organization will have an 8' table. We recommend you bring a tablecloth or other table covering. You can also split a table with another attending organization of your choosing. We require a separate application from each vendor.
- No hot plates for food service will be allowed in the exhibition area.
- There will be no lectures offered for 2022.

What you should bring to the Fair:

- Table covering, banners, signs, easels, and business cards.
- Literature that describes your organization including pamphlets, flyers, posters, etc.
- (If you have any) Give-aways that connects your organization to those interested.

Woodland Senior Center Inc.'s Installation Dinner

The Woodland Senior Center's non-profit partner, Woodland Senior Center Inc. (or SCI), will be hosting its first in-person event since February 2020. The SCI Installation Dinner is held for SCI members to install board members. This year, the dinner will be held on the same day as the Senior Resource Fair, on Thursday May 26 at 5:30 pm. This is a members-only event, and people can RSVP with the Senior Center Welcome Desk at (530) 661-2001. Non-members can sign up at the Woodland Senior Center.

Senior Travel is Trending

The Woodland Senior Center has two main options for seniors wishing to travel. The first is with Senior Center Inc.'s "Affordable Adventures" program, which plans and hosts trips with SCI Board Member and travel specialist, Jan Bello. SCI's trip to Reno's Nugget Casino on April 1 was the first trip carried out. Now they are accepting signups for a trip to Golden Gate Fields on May 22. SCI plans trips year-round and will be working on more.

The second travel option is booking a trip through the Woodland Senior Center with the Collette Travel program. Collette is an international organization that plans group trips all over the world. Currently, there are 20 people signed up for Collette trips, including 12 people going on the "Discover Nashville and the Great Smoky Mountains" trip. Trips can be booked through the Senior Center.
