E. NEW BUSINESS

1. Update on Meals on Wheels Yolo County by Joy Cohan, Executive Director

Joy Cohan updated the Commission on Meals on Wheels' operations. "Operation Accelerate" is an effort for Meals on Wheels to be more nutritious, partnering with Yolo Food Bank for fresh produce, and a way to navigate equitable access to meals, regardless of geographic reach. In April, they served 450 seniors (155 in Woodland), a total of 8,670 meals. This is 5 meals a week, delivered 3 times a week (includes frozen meals). Meals on Wheels is looking to resume in-person congregate dining at the Woodland Community & Senior Center on Wednesdays in July.

3. Woodland Apartment Guide Update

Commissioner Madsen gave an update on her progress with the apartment guide. She received many updates from many of the properties, and asked for the Commission's help in reaching out to the remaining properties. Commission will divide remaining properties and contact them.

4. Senior Resource Fair on May 26, 2022

Staff identified the 54 vendors that will attend the resource fair. It was promoted in the Senior Gram newsletter (mailed to 420 households), a press release to several publications, and social media.

5. Woodland Senior Center Staff Report

The Woodland Senior Center is looking for more volunteers for games and group programs. Looking for Welcome Desk, event volunteers, and group facilitators. Many groups are hurting for volunteers.

Staff updated the Commission on the Yolo County Board of Supervisors' meeting regarding the purchase of the St. John's property. There was overwhelming support from senior-serving agencies. Meals on Wheels is also part of the partnership looking to utilize the commercial kitchen. Yolo Adult Day Health Care would like to use part of it for expanded operations in Yolo county.

Woodland Senior Center Inc.

Woodland Senior Center Inc. is the non-profit partner of the Woodland Senior Center. They provide events, resources, and funding for the Woodland Senior Center and its residents. On May 26, they held their annual Installation Meeting and Dinner, where members of the non-profit voted to install the board and officers. About 100 members were in attendance for a Mexican dinner.

More New and Returning Programs

The Woodland Senior Center has been working to bring back more programming for Woodland seniors.

- The City will be partnering with the Yolo County District Attorney's Office and AARP California to offer a free shred event on Wednesday September 28 from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm at the Woodland Community & Senior Center. Viking Shred will be on-site to accept paper documents to shred. You do not have to be a senior to take part in this event.
- Staff has received commitments from two law offices, as well as Legal Services of Northern California, to offer free legal consultations at the Woodland Senior Center. While the logistics are still being worked out, the intention is to offer appointments to seniors at least twice per month. They will meet in a private consultation office in the Woodland Senior Center.
- Staff has also lined up a few of the insurance professionals from the Resource Fair to offer educational sessions about Medicare. These will be open to the public and cover several healthcare topics for retirement-age people.
