Follow-Up: General Fund Dollars Earmarked for Sustainability

May 17, 2023

After discussions with the Community Development Department, staff prepared the following three possible directions for the \$400K in General Fund dollars that originated from the American Rescue Plan:

1. **Await completion of the Active Transportation Plan (ATP) and allocate towards recommended projects (staff recommendation).** The City's ATP will include "low hanging fruit" projects – in other words, gaps in Woodland's active transportation system that might be a sensible place for short term project spending. Staff anticipates that the ATP will be complete by the end of the calendar year.
2. **Both await ATP completion and identify one or two short term expenditures.** This hybrid approach would identify some projects for even more immediate spending. Examples may include more infrastructure on College Street, additional bike racks, or another "bike course" like at Ferns Park.
3. **Fully allocate towards short-term projects before December 2023.**
