Recommendation for Action: Staff recommends that the City Council: 1) Adopt Resolution No. _____, declaring the official results of the General Municipal Election held on November 5, 2024 and the final Certificates of Canvass related to the election of three (3) members of the City Council for Council Districts 2 (Stallard), 4 (Moreno) and 5 (Vega) with terms expiring upon the election of their successor thereto at the Presidential General Election of 2028, and related to Measure U.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no fiscal impact associated with the recommended action. An invoice for the costs to conduct the election has not yet been received from the Yolo County Elections Office.

Discussion:

On November 5, 2024, a General Municipal Election was held in the City of Woodland for the purpose of electing one (1) District 2 Council Member, one (1) District 4 Council Member, one (1) District 5 Council Member, and voting on one (1) ballot measure (Measure U) which would authorize a second supplemental one cent (\$0.01), or one percent (1%), retail transactions and use (sales) tax within the City of Woodland for a period of eight (8) years to fund maintenance and improvements to City services.

In accordance with City Council Resolution Nos. 8330 and 8331, the City's election was consolidated with the Statewide General Election that was conducted on the same day by the Yolo County Elections Office. The County Clerk-Recorder was responsible for canvassing all votes cast and certifying the election results. The appropriate Resolution has been prepared for adoption, which is attached to this Report. The results are attached as Exhibit "A" to the Resolution.

The Yolo County Elections Office provided Final Election Results to the City on December 3, 2024. The Final Election Results are as follows:

Tom Stallard for City Council District 2 for a term of four years;
David Moreno for City Council District 4 for a term of four years; and
Mayra Vega for City Council District 5 for a term of four years.

Further, a majority of City voters did not approve Measure U, and it was, therefore, not passed.

Conclusion:

Staff recommends that the City Council: 1) Adopt Resolution No. _____, declaring the official results of the General Municipal Election held on November 5, 2024 and the final Certificates of Canvass related to the election of three (3) members of the City Council for Council Districts 2 (Stallard), 4 (Moreno) and 5 (Vega) with terms expiring upon the election of their successor thereto at the Presidential General Election of 2028, and related to Measure U.

RESOLUTION NO. _____

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF WOODLAND RECITING THE FACT OF THE
GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON
NOVEMBER 5, 2024; DECLARING THE RESULTS AND
SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW.**

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Woodland, California, on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in the time, form and manner as provided by law; voting precincts were properly established; election officers were appointed, and in all respects the elections were held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in the time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council; the results are received, attached, and made a part hereof as “Exhibit A”.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Woodland hereby finds, determines and resolves as follows:

SECTION 1. That the whole number of ballots cast in the precincts including vote-by-mail ballots and provisional ballots are detailed in the Official Canvass attached as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2.

That the names of the persons voted for in the election for Member of City Council, District 2 were as follows:

Tom Stallard

That the names of the persons voted for in the election for Member of City Council, District 4 were as follows:

Fred Lopez

David Moreno

That the names of the persons voted for in the election for Member of City Council, District 5 were as follows:

Chukwunedum C. “Chuck” Amajioyi

Mayra Vega

SECTION 3. That the following local Measure voted upon at the election is as follows:

Measure U

"CITY OF WOODLAND SALES TAX MEASURE. To keep Woodland safe, clean and well-maintained by increasing police and fire protection, reducing emergency response times, repairing roads and sidewalks, addressing homelessness, improving and maintaining parks, enhancing programs for children and youth, and for general government use, shall a measure establishing a one cent sales tax, providing approximately \$16,500,000 annually for 8 years, requiring independent audits, public spending disclosures, local control and all funds remaining in Woodland, be adopted?" SECTION 4. That the number of votes cast in each precinct, and the number of votes cast in the City for each of the persons above-named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates, and for and against the Measure, are set forth in "Exhibit A," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 5. The City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election:

- 1) Tom Stallard was elected as a Member of the City Council representing District 2 for the full term of four years;
- 2) David Moreno was elected as a Member of the City Council representing District 4 for the full term of four years;
- 3) Mayra Vega was elected as a Member of the City Council representing District 5 for the full term of four years; and
- 4) A majority of voters voting on Measure U did not vote in favor thereof, the Measure was not carried, and it shall not be deemed adopted and ratified.

SECTION 6. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City of Woodland, a statement of result of the election, showing:

- 1) The whole number of votes/ballots cast in the City;
- 2) The names of the persons voted for;
- 3) The measure voted upon;
- 4) For what office each person was voted;
- 5) The number of votes cast at each precinct for each person, and for and against the measure; and
- 6) The total number of votes cast for each person, and for and against the measure.

SECTION 7. The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the Office of the City Clerk.

Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 8. Compliance with California Environmental Quality Act. The City Council finds that this Resolution is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (“CEQA”) pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2) (the activity will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment) and 15060(c)(3) (the activity is not a project as defined in Section 15378) of the State CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, because it has no potential for resulting in physical change to the environment, directly or indirectly. Further, if the activity is deemed a project this City Council finds that this Resolution is exempt pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines.

SECTION 9. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

SECTION 10. Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, or clause or phrase in this Resolution or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Resolution or any part thereof. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted each section irrespective of the fact that any one or more subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, or phrases are declared unconstitutional, invalid, or ineffective.

SECTION 11. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.

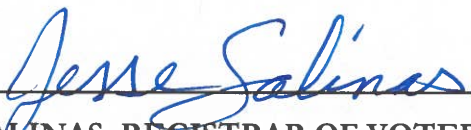
