### **Collette Travel**

In calendar year 2024, the Woodland Senior Center was part of seven Collette Trips: Costa Rica, Portugal, Amish Country, Canadian Rockies, Iceland, Niagara Falls/NYC, and Historical Greenbrier. Over these trips, there were 21 travelers which brought in revenue exceeding \$91,000. The Woodland Senior Center receives a 10% commission from every trip sold, which helps to pay for the Senior Center Coordinator position.
